

CLUB RULES

Move quietly and orderly from activity to activity; remain quiet during Teaching Times.

Gum chewing is not allowed. Food and drinks may be served from time to time for special occasions.

Clubbers should stay with their leader during Large Group Time. Clubbers should give full attention to the leader or speaker.

Bathroom and drink breaks are permitted during Game and Handbook Times only. Check with your leader before leaving your group.

A 'five-count' means to come to attention immediately. The entire group must be quiet by the end of the count number five.

Three count system of individual discipline; given by Director:

1st count – warning

2nd count- sent to Commander

3rd count- parents are notified and clubber will be removed from club. Clubber will be asked to miss the next club meeting only to return the following meeting. If behavior is severe, clubber may be permanently removed from the club.

CLUB POLICIES

Clubbers must complete their Entrance Booklet before receiving their uniform and handbook.

Uniforms must be paid for before being received by the clubbers. Books are paid for by the church but not replacements if lost.

Awards will be given **ONLY** to clubbers in uniform.

Clubbers should try to complete at least two sections per club meeting to finish their handbook by the end of the year.

Clubbers must complete the entire section in one sitting with no more than two helps per section.

Sections may not be signed off by parents or another family member.

Award is given for each seven times at a club meeting per quarter.

Award is given for each fourteen times at Sunday School, Church, or equivalent per half year.
